TO ALL PARTIES (INCLUDING YOU) WILL NOT EXCEED THE APPLICABLE LIABILITY CAP FOR SUCH CERTIFICATE SET FORTH IN THE TABLE, BELOW.

THE COMBINED AGGREGATE LIABILITY OF ALL ISSUING AUTHORITIES AND TRUST ITALIA TO ANY AND ALL PERSONS CONCERNING A SPECIFIC CERTIFICATE SHALL BE LIMITED TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE FOLLOWING, FOR THE AGGREGATE OF ALL DIGITAL SIGNATURES AND TRANSACTIONS RELATED TO SUCH CERTIFICATE:
